We are in the process of reviewing these, as well as previous candidates, and plan to conduct initial screenings in the near future. OUTREACH UPDATE - March 26

As we continue to adjust to the "new normal" of our lives impacted by physical distancing, we at BCC want to continue to remember and help some of those who are being most impacted by the COVID-19 outbreak. We have reached out to another ministry partner, Presencia, which normally operates an afterschool program for 51 elementary children at Bloom at Dreseden Park Apartments in Atlanta. Although this program is currently suspended, there is an opportunity to support the families of these children with grocery store gift cards. According to Ruth Ann North, executive director, most of the parents (who are primarily immigrants) are either hourly, lowwage, or service workers whose incomes are being drastically affected. "These are tough times upon already tough times for most of our families," she said. In addition to the grocery store gift cards, Presencia is putting together and distributing backpacks full of enrichment activities and school supplies for the kids.
